**Byron Davies to talk at YES Brooklands Aviation Education Conference.**

Mr Byron Davies, recently appointed as the first ever "Champion for General Aviation" by the Government and the first chairman of the All Party Parliamentary Group for General Aviation, will be the keynote speaker at the LAA's Youth and Education Strut Aviation Education Conference at Brooklands Museum, Weybridge, Surrey on March 10.

Mr. Davies has been tasked by the Government to gather evidence of the GA sector's value to the economy and the need for a protected network of airfields.
